## Are you entitled to Free School Meals?

Each year the government collect school data on a specific day regarding pupil numbers, staff etc. This year it is Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2018. This data generates the funds that the school receives for the coming year. Free School Meals is one of the factors included. If you think that your child/children are entitled but you are not claiming Free School Meals at the moment we would appreciate you registering to enable us to claim additional funding. You may be entitled to free meals if you are receipt of qualifying.

Please contact Miss Jeffels at the school office if you think you may be entitled, application forms are available at the school office, please call, if possible by Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> January. Your child does not need to take school meals, however it does increase our funding if you are registered. Thank you.

## Attendance & Punctuality

Please continue to ensure your child attends whenever possible, and that you contact the school on the first day of absence to ensure we know the reason. Punctuality is also very important and is achieved by the vast majority of our children. Please help us to achieve our target of 96% this term.
