## Health & Safety

May we politely remind parents of the following:

- No cars should come onto the school site at the start and end of the school day. The exceptions to this are agreed by prior arrangement with the Headteacher due to special circumstances or those displaying a Disabled Badge.
- Yellow lines at the school entrance should be kept 'traffic free'.
- No dogs are allowed on the school site. Many children are scared of dogs and lots of children in a confined area can be unsettling for even the most placid animal.
- Parents and children are asked not to ride bikes on the school site.

These precautions help to ensure the safety of your children.

We have welcomed many new staff to our team this year and we know they will contribute to the wonderful quality of teaching and learning that we aim to provide. As a school we always try to do our very best for our children and their parents.
