Happy New Year!

We are delighted to be back at school after the break and to warm but wet weather! We appreciate however that this can change and normal winter weather return at any time. The Local Authority is investigating what action can be taken in these instances as it is illegal for children to be exposed to content of this nature. We are more than happy to talk to them on your behalf if this is the case.

We are delighted to now have two members of staff dedicated to supporting our children and their families.
