- Yellow lines at the school entrance should be kept 'traffic free'.
- No dogs are allowed on the school site. Many children are scared of dogs and lots of children in a confined area can be unsettling for even the most placid animal.
- Parents and children are asked not to ride bikes on the school site. We have a bike shed for the Key Stage 2 pupils to use but unfortunately have no capacity for Reception and Key Stage 1.
