

How to activate your account

1. Download the Android or iPhone app.





- Press 'Sign Up' then enter the email and mobile number your school has on record. If you're not sure if they have the right details, it's best to check and update first.
- Press 'Send PIN'. You will receive a text message with your unique PIN.
- You're now ready to log in and start using School Gateway.
- If you don't have a smartphone or prefer to use a computer, you can set up your account using <u>the web version</u> of School Gateway.

You may have already received this letter via email, if not this will be because we do not have up to date contact details for you. In future all letters will be emailed so please make sure you update your contact details with us. Only 41% of our families have registered with School Gateway, if you are not one of them please use the above instructions to do so
